

Activities from January to March, 2011 for Quarterly Bulletin

1. **Training Programme in Vocational Guidance for Vocational Teachers from Minority groups:**

A Training Programme in Vocational Guidance for Vocational Teachers from Minority groups was organized from 11 to 15 January, 2011 at PSSCIVE, Bhopal. The programme was inaugurated by Prof. Nisha Dubey, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Barkatullah Vishwavidyalaya, Bhopal. The Programme Coordinator welcomed the Chief Guest, resource persons and the participants from the States of Goa (07), Kerala (12), Punjab (03) and Odisha (01). The participants were requested to give their introduction. The Programme Coordinator told about the background and the objectives of the training programme and also about the content of the five days schedule. The Chief Guest in her address also welcomed the participants and requested them to take maximum benefit of this opportunity. In the academic sessions resource persons discussed the topics related to vocational education and training, the need and importance of guidance and counseling, career information service, placement service and self employment opportunities for vocational pass-outs etc. The participants were given individual/group assignments such as preparation of career talks, charts, posters and school-wise action plan. Each participant presented career talk. Field visits to RUDSET institute and Regional Institute of Education, Bhopal were organized. In the valedictory session, Prof. S.Z. Haider, Former Joint Director distributed certificates to the participants. Dr. Kiran Mathur was the Programme Coordinator of the programme.

2. **Academic Enrichment Lecture Series:**

Academic Enrichment Lecture was organized on 17th January, 2011 at PSSCIVE, NCERT, Bhopal. Prof. A. K. Sacheti, former I/c Joint Director of PSSCIVE, presently working as Project Advisor, UNDP, RMoL was invited as chief guest to deliver the lecture. About 70 participants including faculty and staff members of PSSCIVE, RIE and Vocational lecturers of Bhopal attended the programme and benefited from the lecture-cum-discussion session on "A Non formal Model of Skill Training for

Unemployed Youth as Practiced in Rajasthan", delivered by Prof. Sacheti. The participants actively participated by raising the relevant queries to know how successfully the Rajasthan Mission on Skill and Livelihood is running Vocational Programme for Non-formal youths. The speaker shared his views, work and modalities for executing the project successfully at RMoL. Sh. Deepak Shudhalwar, Assistant Professor coordinated the programme. Dr. Pinki Khanna, Associate Professor acted as resource person for this programme.

3. **Orientation of Madarsa Key Functionaries of M.P. to implement VET:**

An Orientation of Madarsa Key Functionaries of Madhya Pradesh to implement VET the programme was organized from 18-20 January, 2011 at PSSCIVE, Bhopal. The participants were acquainted with the importance of VET for Madarsa students. Various presentations and lectures on different aspects of VET were delivered by PSSCIVE faculty. They were taken to visit of two organizations offering vocational courses. Participants also presented their views to offer VET programme in Madarsa. Various schemes of the government were also discussed by M.P. Madarsa Board officials. Resource persons were also invited to deliver lecture on VET and motivation. Each participant developed action plan for their Madarsa to run VET programme. The programme was coordinated by Dr. Asfa M. Yasin, Associate Professor.

4. **National Meeting on providing vertical linkage to +2 Home Science Vocational Passouts:**

A National Meeting on providing vertical linkage to +2 Home Science Vocational Passouts was organized from 11-12 January, 2011 at PSSCIVE, Bhopal. The National Meeting was attended by 19 Home Science Experts. The Vice Chancellor of Barkatullah University inaugurated the meeting. A session was held on vocational education at +2 level. The other sessions were held to discuss the vocational courses offered at +2 level and the scheme of examination at national level. Discussions were held with the experts and it was discussed that +2 vocational Home Science students can be provided vertical mobility at

Tertiary level. Dr. Suniti Sanwal, Associate Professor was the Programme Coordinator.

- 5. Orientation Programme for Commerce based Vocational Teachers of Andhra Pradesh:** The Orientation Programme for Commerce based vocational teachers in the State of Andhra Pradesh was held at NITTTR Branch, Maseb Tank, Hyderabad from 27-31 January, 2011. 34 Commerce based vocational Junior Lecturers from three regions of Andhra Pradesh participated in the programme. During this programme participants were oriented about Status of VEP in Andhra Pradesh, VEP in India, Stages in Vocational Education, Development of Vocational curricula and Instructional Material, School Industry Linkages and On-the-Job Training, Opportunities in Commerce based courses, Role of Industry Sector for Implementation of Vocational Education, Production-cum-Training Centres and Apprenticeship Training, Entrepreneurship Development programme, Distribution System in APSEB and Developments in Accounting. Field visits were also arranged to IDBI Baserbag branch, Andhra Pradesh Cooperative Bank, National Council of Rural Institutions and Probel Vocational Junior College, Hyderabad. Participants were divided in three groups region wise to do group work on issues of implementation of VEP. Group leaders presented the group work reports. Suggestions given by other group members were incorporated in their group work reports. Dr. P. Veeraiah, Assistant Professor, was programme coordinator.
- 6. Minority Institution Teachers' Training Programme on VET. (Prog. of PPMED, NCERT):** A Minority Institution Teachers' Training Programme on Vocational Education and Training was organized from 17-19 February, 2011 at PSSCIVE, Bhopal. To acquaint participants with the importance of VET for students of Minority institutions, various presentations and lectures on different aspects of VET were delivered by PSSCIVE faculty and resource person of other organizations. Resource persons were also invited to deliver lecture on VET and motivation. Each participant developed action

plan for their institutions to run VET programme. Report of the programme would be sent to Minority Cell, NCERT for the feedback and suggestions for organizing programmes in future. Dr. Asfa M. Yasin, Associate Professor coordinated the programme.

- 8. Competency Based Skill Training Programme for Teachers of Agriculture Based Voc. Courses:** A Competency Based Skill Training Programme for Teachers of Agriculture Based Vocational Courses was organized from 1-4 February, 2011 at Hissar, Haryana. The programme was attended by the agriculture based vocational teachers of Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Jharkhand and Bihar states. During the programme lecture-cum-discussion sessions were held. Lectures were taken on competency based training, SIL and establishment of PTC in the schools. During the programme discussion were made with the teachers about difficulties concerning implementation of VET in the states. Visit was arranged to provide exposure of different agriculture based vocational activities. For group work different tasks as per course have been assigned to the participants in which writing the competency statement, element, performance indicator/criteria of selected activities were taken into consideration. Dr. R.K. Pathak, Associate Professor coordinated the programme.
- 9. Capacity Building of Key Functionaries Working for VET of ST Community:** Capacity Building programme of Key Functionaries working for VET of ST Community was conducted from 14-16 February, 2011 at PSSCIVE, Bhopal. The programme was attended by 28 vocational teachers/ principals of Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand states. During the programme lecture-cum- discussion were held to bring out the awareness about need and importance of VET for ST in the states. Lectures were also taken on importance of Vocational Education, role of guidance and Counselling in Vocational Education, School-Industry Linkage (SIL), Production-cum- Training Centre (PTC), On-the-Job Training (OJT), role of banks and financial schemes for vocational passouts,

empowerment of ST community through vocational education, etc. Field visit was also organized to provide exposure of running different vocational trades. During the programme discussion were made with participants about the difficulties concerning to VET in the states. Programme was coordinated by Dr. R.K. Pathak, Associate Professor.

10. Orientation Programme for Vocational Teachers of Scheduled Caste Community:

An Orientation Programme for Vocational Teachers of Scheduled Caste Community was organized from 22-25 February, 2011 at PSSCIVE, Bhopal. The programme was attended by the vocational teachers/ instructors of Scheduled caste category from different states. During the programme lecture-cum-discussion sessions were held. Lectures were taken on different aspects of Vocational Education. During the programme discussion were made with teachers. Visit was arranged to Bhagwan Kala Kendra, RUDSET Institute and Munshi Husain Khan Institute, Bhopal. For group work issues were assigned to the participants to prepare an action plan. Dr. Uadal Singh, Assistant Professor coordinated the programme.

11. Development of Instructional Manual for Fish Culture Voc. Modular Curricula, Phase II:

The instructional material was prepared by the Coordinator for five modules viz., Seaweed Culture, Freshwater Fish Culture, Brackish-water Fish Culture, Ornamental Fish Culture and Prawn Culture. The instructional material was sent to the five experts for review in the first phase. As per review in the first phase, changes were made in the material and sent to the experts for second review. Dr. Asfa M. Yasin was coordinator of the programme.

12. Teacher Training Programme in the area of Insurance Vocational Course:

The Teachers Training Programme in the area of Insurance Vocational Course was held at Seminar Hall, Newzealand Hostel, Aarey Solony, Goregaon (E), Mumbai from 8-17 March, 2011. In this programme 26 vocational Teachers and Instructors from six regions of Maharashtra State participated. During 10 days period participant teachers and instructors learned by

the lecture-cum- discussions in the core aspects for Implementation of VEP and in the subject area of Insurance Vocational Course. Industrial visits were also arranged for the participants. They visited Max New York Life Insurance Corporation, Birla Sun Life Insurance Corporation, Life Insurance Corporation of India and General Insurance Training Centre in Mumbai local. Participants were divided in five groups and were assigned issues related to implementation of VEP for group work, and their observations and comments. The group leaders made the presentations of group work and suggestion given by other group members were incorporated. Dr. P. Veeraiah, Assistant Professor, coordinated the programme.

13. Teacher Training Programme on Automobile Technology Trade of Punjab, MP and Chattisgarh:

Teacher Training Programme was conducted with M/s Hero Honda Area Office Learning centre for the first three days from 21-23 March, 2011. Important topic covered in the period was Repair and Maintenance of two wheelers (motorcycle), engine and its component, CDI Technology, carburetor setting, MF Battery, F1 Ignition, Break, etc. Practical exercise was also conducted by the firm. Rest 3 days training programme was conducted on four wheelers section. 10 Teachers from Punjab, MP and Chhattisgarh states participated in the programme. Sh.
